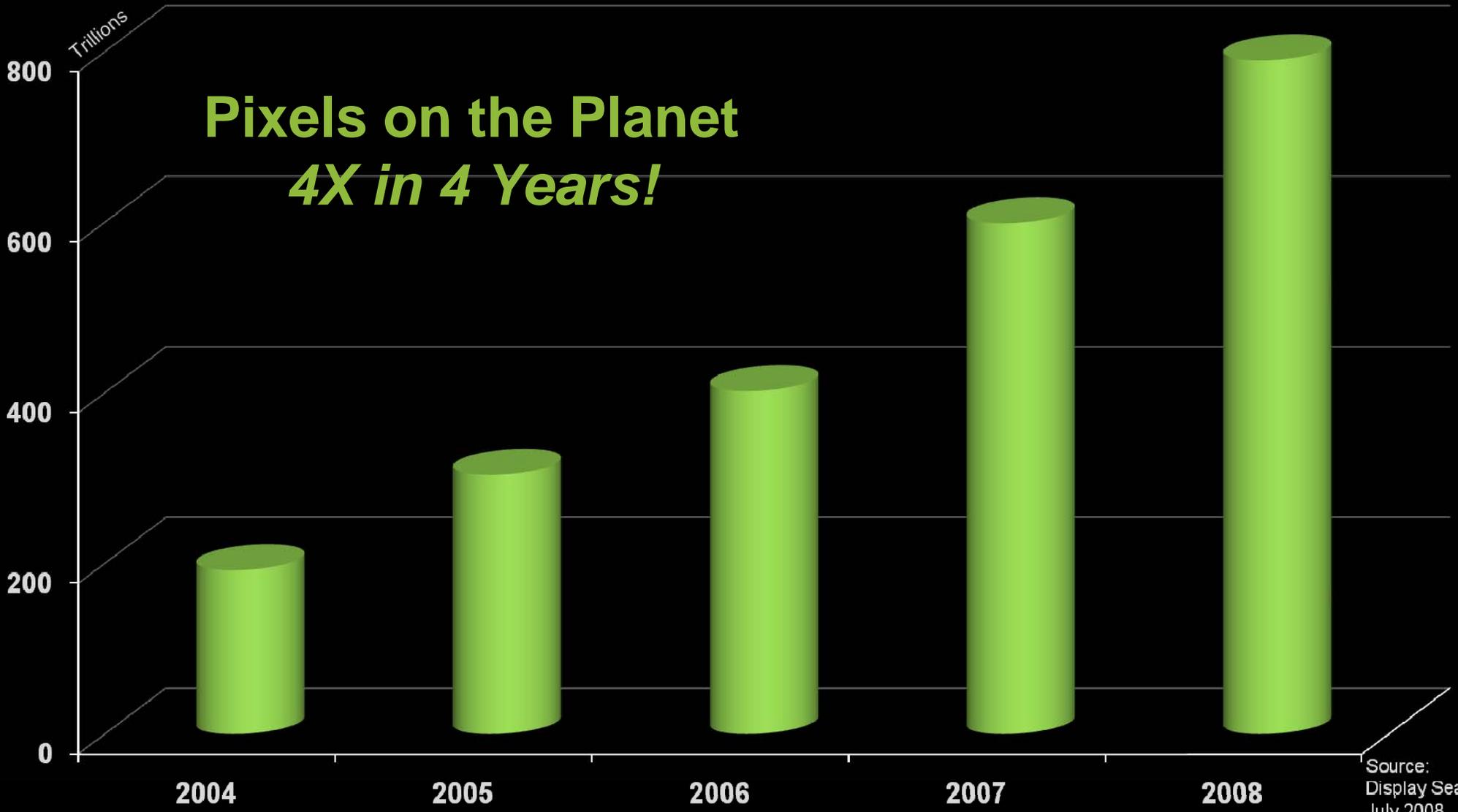

**Rather than wait for companies to develop applications for its hardware, Nvidia funds early-stage software developers, such as Keyhole, whose programs in return use Nvidia's graphics chips to process images not typically associated with the company, such as maps.**

"Anywhere you see an image displayed," said Jeff Herbst, vice president of business development, "it's Nvidia's goal to be there."

The Santa Clara, Calif., company's graphics processing units, or GPUs, transform 3D calculations into images so that a computer's central processing unit, or CPU, is free to perform other functions.

But some on Wall Street are concerned that declining sales of personal computers will translate into lower revenue growth for Nvidia.

"The main driver for Nvidia is its underlying market, the PC industry,"
