



## ICERA SIGNS PROTOCOL STACK DEAL

Icera and Motorola agree distribution and development license for multimode HSDPA protocol stack

**Bristol, UK, June 18 2007.** Icera Inc., the cellular wireless semiconductor company, has today announced a significant extension to its license agreement with Motorola which provides Icera with full rights to distribute and further develop the Motorola TTPCom cellular 2G/3G/HSDPA protocol stack.

Under the terms of the new license agreement, Icera will have the right to distribute the stack software to customers as an integrated part of all of its products, including its Espresso™ cellular WWAN mini card platform solutions. The new license also covers support services to Icera for a defined period of time. Icera development and support teams in Bristol and Cambridge, UK and Sophia Antipolis, France, will provide its customer with support for the products.

Icera has licensed the Motorola TTPCom 2G/3G/HSDPA protocol stack since late 2004 and the technology is being shipped by Icera on its Livanto® silicon devices in commercial products today. The technology has been proven in over 100 million handsets shipped worldwide, including full dual mode 2G/3G devices shipping on major cellular operator networks.

“The Motorola TTPCom stack is one of the most capable and mature products on the market today and is the most widely accepted independent protocol stack available,” said Stan Boland, President & CEO of Icera. “This new deal helps ensure that we can distribute the stack directly as an integral part of Icera’s solutions and can develop it to meet future market requirements.”

The commercial terms of the license agreement were not disclosed.
